



COMMITMENT TO ESTABLISH THE REGULATORY COOPERATION FORUM

Considering the agreed **Regulatory Cooperation Principles,** the Chemical Industry Associations in Latin **America** have decided to establish a Latin **American Regulatory Cooperation Forum (LARCF)** and agreed to follow **common objectives** to promote the implementation and establishmentofthe regulatory systems of consisting, economically efficient and scientifically based chemicals in Latin American countries.

The **LARCF** undertakes to:

• **Improve regulatory cooperation** between Chemical Industry Associations in Latin America and increase participation in projects aligned with the guidelines and principles of ICCA to optimize the use of resources and achieve better performance in the chemical sector.

• Leverage dialogue and information sharing on regulatory developments within the regional industry network and government networks to build stronger relationships between industry associations, member companies and regulators.

• Promote **training initiatives** for governments and Chemical Industry Associations in Latin America related to priority topics such as OECD requirements and SAICM objectives, drawing on international regulatory best practices and the experience of companies and experts.

• **Establish an** industry vision and **roadmap** for regulatory cooperation to support the implementation of chemicals management systems by Latin American governments.

• **Support the National Associations of the Chemical Industry** in Latin America in the alignment of positions on key international regulatory issues, especially those related to the integral management of chemical substances.
